Awards include the Wal-Mart Teacher of the Year Award in 2004, the Excellence in Middle School Mathematics Teaching Award, the 2008 National-Louis University Excellence Award in recognition of excellence in teaching, the Lola May Leadership Award, the 2008 Max Beberman Award for outstanding service in the field of mathematics education, and membership in the Illinois State University College of Education Hall of Fame in 2002. She has presented over 1,000 mathematics sessions/workshops for teachers and has co-authored 11 mathematics education books, 35 professional articles and two computer software packages.
